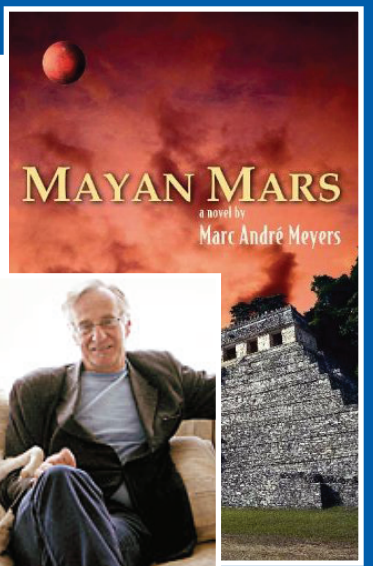
PHILIP GOSCIENSKI

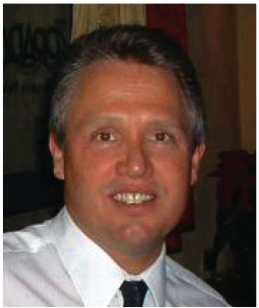
MARC ANDRÉ MEYERS

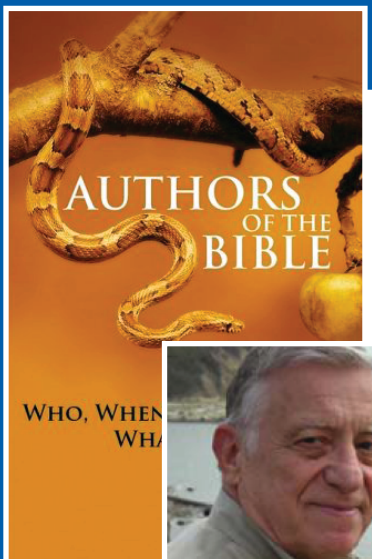
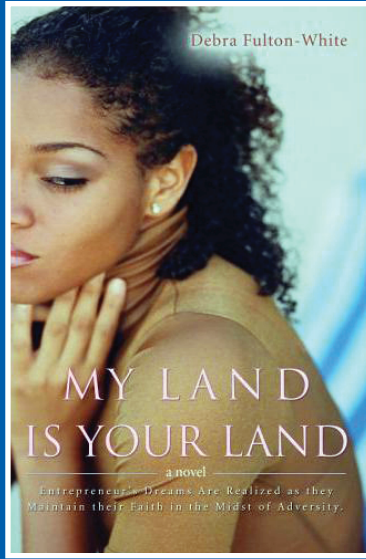
KEITH JONES
